



Transport of Dangerous Goods Course (2 day)

This course covers anyone transporting packaged bulk dangerous goods.

Course objective:

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to prepare for the transport of bulk dangerous goods, including assessing suitability of transport mode for the intended load, checking the bulk dangerous goods load, checking emergency procedures and equipment, evaluating documented route plan, and completing required assessment process. The operator of the vehicle/wagon/mode of transport may be required to be licensed in accordance with the Road Transport Reform (Dangerous Goods) regulations and/or other statutory requirements.

Course Outcome:

On successful completion of course students will be issued with a statement of attainment for the unit TLID2807C and notice of satisfactory assessment to be used to apply for certificate of competency from Safework SA (at an additional cost of \$39.25 made payable to Safework SA).

Course Content:

- Assess suitability of transport mode for intended load
- Check bulk dangerous goods load
- Identify and follow emergency procedures and equipment
- Evaluate documented route plan
- Complete documentation
- Breathing apparatus and Fire fighting
