



A bridge beam with two hooks and/or cabin – 4 operational moves with two hooks, up/down north/south east/west.

Course objective:

To provide the participants with the skills and knowledge to undertake Bridge and Gantry crane operation at work in accordance with Safe Work Australia's National Standard for Licencing Persons Performing High Risk Work (April 2006).

Course Outcome:

On successful completion students will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for TLILIC3003A Licence to operate a bridge and gantry crane.

Course Content:

- Plan work
- Conduct Routine checks
- Transfer Loads
- Shutdown a secure crane

Course Prerequisites:

- Participants must be over 18
- Able to use and understand basic English
- Be able to work at heights
- A basic understanding of mathematics is required which includes multiplication, subtraction and division. Additionally students must be able to use a calculator.

Assessment:

Assessment carried out to National Licencing Standard

- Theory Assessment
- Practical Demonstration & Assessment

Large Classroom:

- White board and marker

Maximum students: 6

Students must:

- Wear fully enclosed steel cap footwear, shirt and long pants/trousers.
- **Photo Identification is mandatory** for certification courses (ie Australian Drivers licence, Passport or Proof of Age card). ID must contain photo, signature and date of birth.
- Students **must** read learning material prior to attending.

Students who fail to comply with these requirements will not be allowed to attend the course.

(Training 2 days with the assessment to be conducted approximately 1 week after training)

Late arrivals will not be permitted to attend the course.
