Course objective:

To provide the learner with the skills and knowledge to operate a Non Slewing Mobile Crane (CN) in accordance with Safe Work Australia's National Standard for Licencing Persons Performing High Risk Work (April 2006).

Course Outcome:

On successful completion students will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for TLILIC3006A Licence to operate a Non Slewing Mobile Crane (greater than 3 tonnes capacity)

Course Content:

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Set up crane
- Transfer loads
- Mobile load
- Shutdown and secure crane

Course Prerequisites:

Training -

- Participants must be over 18
- Able to use and understand basic English
- A basic understanding of mathematics is required which includes multiplication, subtraction and division. Additionally students must be able to use a calculator.

Assessment -

- Having a log book of evidence of hours signed off by ticketed person/or letter from employer will assist in the practical assessment process. (Please note: any on the job training must be carried out under direct supervision of a suitably qualified person).

Assessment:

Assessment carried out to National Licencing Standard

- Theory Assessment
- Practical Assessment (Demonstration)

Training at your premises

To conduct Training and Assessment on site at your premises, the Site Resource and Infrastructure requirements as defined by SafeWork SA must be confirmed. Please contact our office on 08 8169 9800 for a quote and to discuss this further.

Facilities required

Classroom:

- White board with marker pens
- Chairs and tables
- Power

Other:

- Non Slewing Mobile Crane with a capacity of 3 tonnes or more, in a safe, serviceable and compliant condition
- Safe area for Non Slewing Crane operation — as per Resource and Infrastructure requirements.
- Slings and Loads

Minimum students: 4

Maximum students: 6

Students must:

- Wear fully enclosed steel cap footwear, shirt and long pants/trousers.
- **Photo Identification is mandatory for certification courses** (ie Australian Drivers licence, Passport or Proof of Age card). ID must contain photo, signature and date of birth. .

Students who fail to comply with these requirements will not be allowed to attend the course.

Course start time and duration:

Total - 4 Days

7:45 for 8am start - training 24 hours / 3 days

7:45 for 8am start - assessments allow 8 hours / 1 day

Assessments will take place approx 1 week after the training.

Late arrivals will not be permitted to attend the course.
