Training -

- Able to use and understand basic English

- Having a log book of evidence of hours signed off by ticketed person/or letter from employer will assist in the practical assessment process. (Please note: any on the job training must be carried out under direct supervision of a suitable qualified person).

Mandatory Student Requirements:

Training -

- Suitable personal protective equipment (Steel toe footwear, hard hat, long sleeve shirt and long pants).

Assessment -

- **Photo Identification is mandatory** for certification courses (ie Australian Drivers licence, Passport or Proof of Age card). ID must contain photo, signature and date of birth.
- Students **must** read learning material prior to attending.
- Assessment is a combination of theory and practical components. Participants are encouraged to document any on the job training they may have received by way of log books or records of training which must be countersigned by an appropriately qualified person.

Students who fail to comply with these requirements will not be allowed to attend the course.
