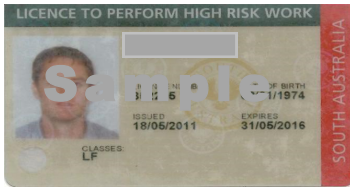

### Course Objective

To provide the participant with the skills and knowledge to operate a Slewing Mobile Crane up to 20 tonne capacity (C2) in accordance with Safe Work Australia's National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work (April 2006).

### Course Outcome

- Notice of Satisfactory Assessment and Tax Invoice
- High Risk Licence (C2) issued by SafeWork SA \*see over page

### Course Content

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Set up crane
- Transfer loads
- Conduct lifts in a variety of configurations
- Shutdown and secure crane

### Course Prerequisites

- Ability to read, write, speak and understand basic English.
- Students must be 18 years of age to undertake assessment.
- **Learners must hold a current Dogging High Risk Work Licence**
- A basic understanding of mathematics is required which includes the use of formulas. Additionally students must be able to use a calculator.

**NOTE: RPL pathway is not available for this course due to licensing requirements. Learners are required to complete the full training program.**

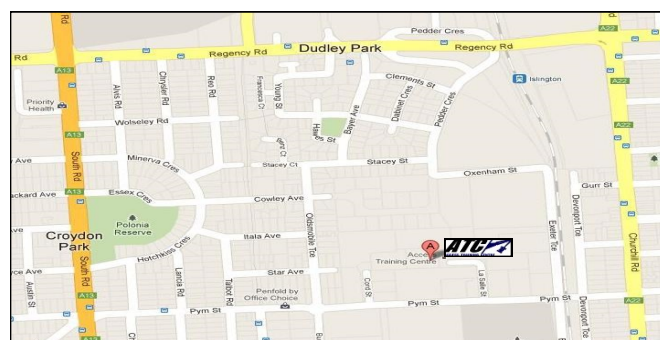
#### Facilities Required:

- Slewing Mobile Crane (must be above 20 tonne but no greater than 60 tonne capacity) in a safe, serviceable and compliant condition
- Safe area for Slewing Mobile Crane operation - as per Resource and Infrastructure requirements
- Slings and associated equipment in compliant condition
- 2 way radios
- Suitable loads for lifts as per Resource and Infrastructure requirements
