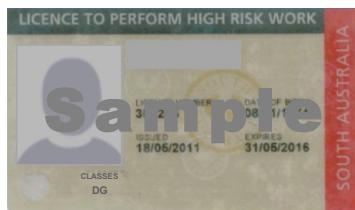

Course Objective

To provide the participant with the skills and knowledge to undertake Dogging activities in accordance with Safe Work Australia's National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

Course Outcome

On successful completion of this course learners will be issued

- Statement of Attainment
- Notice of Satisfactory Assessment and Tax Invoice
- High Risk Licence (DG) issued by SafeWork SA

Course Content

- Plan task
- Select and inspect equipment
- Set up task
- Perform task
- Pack up and clean up

Learner Requirements

- Ability to read, write, speak and understand English
- Learners must be 18 years of age to undertake assessment.
- An understanding of mathematics is required which includes multiplication, subtraction and division.
- Learners must be able to use a calculator
- Having a log book of evidence of hours signed off by a ticketed person /or letter from employer will assist participants in the successful completion of the program

NOTE: RPL pathway is not available for this course due to licensing requirements. Learners are required to complete the full training program.

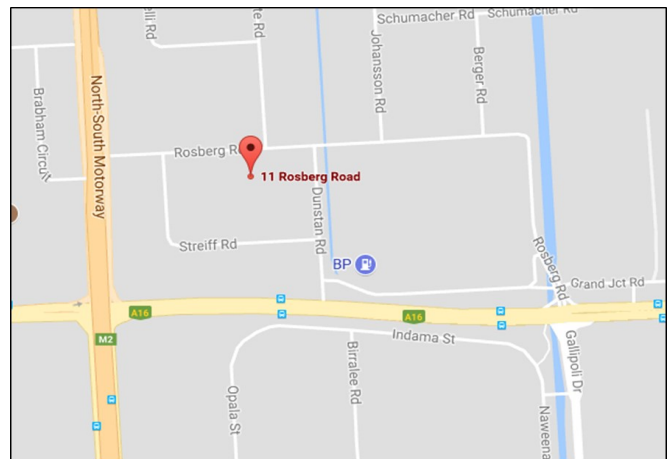
