Learner Requirements

- Hold a current Dogging High Risk Work Licence
- Hold a current C2 or C6 High Risk Work Licence with operational experience
- Ability to read, write, speak and understand English
- Students must be 18 years of age to undertake assessment
- An understanding of mathematics is required which includes multiplication, subtraction and division.
- Learners must be able to use a calculator
- Logged hours of operating experience on a Slewing Crane including;
 - * Knowledge and currency of whistle signals and two way radios
 - Detailed experience in Mobile Slew Crane set up including working and operating outriggers
 - Being proficient in the setup and use of ancillary equipment including counterweight requirements, fly jibs and bayonets
 - Undertaking assessment of ground conditions
 - * Demonstrate sound knowledge of crane load charts in all configurations

NOTE: RPL pathway is not available for this course due to licensing requirements.

Learners are required to complete the full training program.
