Crystalline Silica Safety Awareness (3.5 hours)

Course Objective

This awareness training course is approved by SafeWork SA to assist Persons Conducting a Business or Undertaking (PCBU) to provide training to workers about the risks of crystalline silica.

From 1 September 2024 PCBUs must provide crystalline silica training to workers if:

- they are involved in processing of a crystalline silica substance (CSS) that is high risk; or
- they are at risk of exposure to respirable crystalline silica (RCS) because of the processing of crystalline silica substance that is high risk.

If workers are not undertaking high risk processing, PCBUs must still provide appropriate information, instruction, training or supervision to anyone who may be exposed to RCS at the workplace.

Course Outcome

On successful completion of this course, students will be issued with:

- Understand what silica is and where it is commonly found
- Identify health risks associated with exposure to respirable crystalline silica (RCS)
- How RCS is generated during processing
- Workplace exposure standards and controlled processing of crystalline silica substances (CSS)
- Types of respirator protective equipment (RPE) and compliance requirements including fit checking and fit testing of equipment
- Control plans and Safe Work Method Statements
- Cleaning methods to minimise risk of exposure to RCS
- WHS Regulation requirements

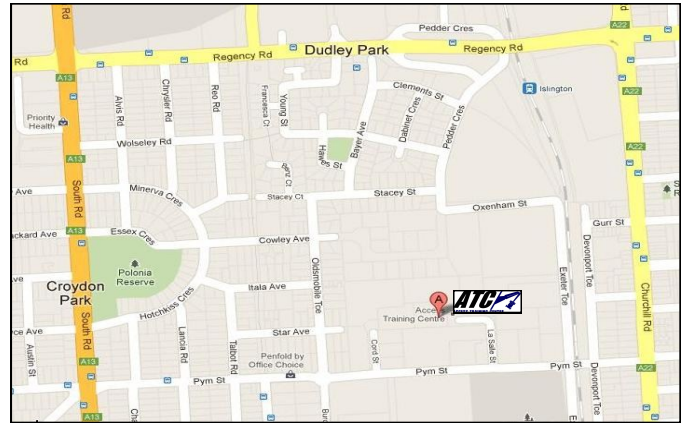
