Course Objective

To provide learners with the skills and knowledge to operate a Vehicle Loading Crane (CV) in accordance with Safe Work Australia's National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

Course Outline

Day 1 - 2: Training and Assessment to TLILIC0024 Licence to Operate a Vehicle Loading Crane (capacity of 10 metre tonnes and over) (VET Unit)

Day 3 - 4: SafeWork SA High Risk Work Licence (HRWL) Assessment

Note: Competency must be achieved to the VET Unit prior to commencing the HRWL Assessment. If Competency to the VET Unit is not achieved, the course will need to be extended and additional fees will apply.

It is **strongly recommended** that learners read the Training Manual prior to attending.

Learner Suitability

This course is recommended for Learners with a current Dogging HRWL licence that are required to operate a Vehicle Loading Crane with a capacity of 10 metre tonnes or more. Dogging experience slinging loads and directing cranes is highly recommended for this course.


