Health and Safety Representatives (HSRs) play a crucial role in the workplace representing the health and safety interests of workers in the work group.

Under section 72 of the Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA) employers are required to provide elected HSRs access to training once elected by the workgroup.

Health and Safety Representative (HSR) Training - Level 1 (5 Days)

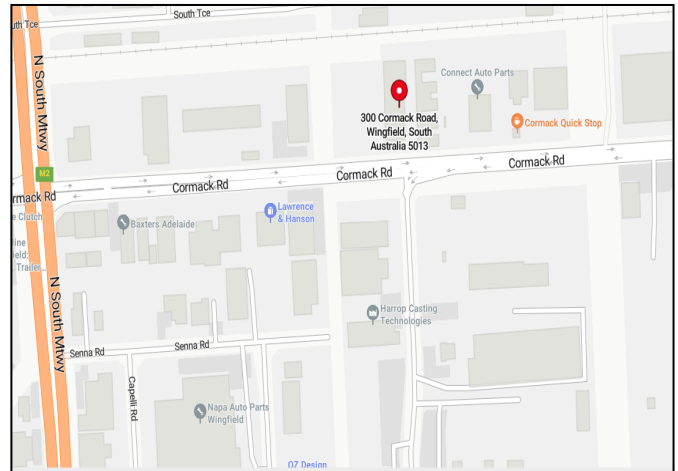
