Under section 72 of the Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA) employers are required to provide elected HSRs access to training once elected by the workgroup.

Health and Safety Representative (HSR) Training - Level 1 (5 Days)

Training Entitlements

All elected HSRs and deputy HSRs are entitled to attend approved training during each year of their term of office. HSRs may choose the course and training provider, in consultation with their PCBU regarding location, timing and reasonable costs involved.
