Practical Experience (TMI1) and Assessment (TMI1 & TC1) (1 Day) to be completed within 6 months

On completion of the log book, Access Training Centre will provide a suitable Temporary Traffic Management (TTM) live site work environment for the Student's practical experience for TMI1 with TTM qualified operators to supervise and support Students. Two observations will be completed and documented by a suitably qualified Supervisor while implementing different live traffic setups as detailed on Traffic Guidance Schemes (TGS).

On completion of the TMI1 practical experience, Students will be required to successfully complete the Final TMI1 Assessment autonomously interpreting a TGS and implementing the required TTM set up on a live traffic project as advised by the Assessor. Students will also complete the TC1 Assessment on this live worksite.

On successful completion of the assessment, Students will be issued with:

- Statement of Attainment issued by ATC
- TTM card issued by DIT (Department for Infrastructure and Transport)
