Training Course

This is a course for Students who will be responsible for developing traffic management plans (TMP) and traffic guidance schemes (TGSs) on High Volume roads (Category 2).

Bring your own device. A laptop and charger is required to conduct in course and post course assessment activities.

Post Course – to be completed within 6 months

Students are required to complete two traffic management plans (TMP) and a minimum of one associated Traffic Guidance Scheme (TGS) in the workplace, using a live project.

To complete the post course assessments, the student will need access to a suitably qualified and experienced Traffic Management Designer to guide and act as a Supervisor while the TMP/TGSs are developed.

It is highly recommended that you have access to the TMP design software being used in your workplace.

Examples of TMP design software includes; Rapid Plan, Auto Cad, Road Manager, Corel Draw, MS Paint, Google Draw.

Course Content

- Plan and implement risk management processes including identifying hazards and developing risk controls
- Auditing the risk management process and completing records
- Establish context for traffic management plan and traffic guidance scheme
- Prepare traffic management plan and associated traffic guidance schemes
- Review traffic management plan implementation

Student Requirements

- Ability to read, write, speak and understand English
- Students must be at least 18 years of age
- **Students are required to be recredited every 3 years**
- **Students must provide evidence** of the following:
 - **Completion of:**
 - * RIISS00063 Traffic Management Designer Skill Set for Urban Streets and Low Volume Roads which includes the pre-requisite unit RIICWD503E Prepare traffic management plans and traffic guidance schemes;
 - * **AND** At least 6 months experience applying the Traffic Management Designing skills and knowledge in a temporary traffic management workplace
 - * **AND** Provide evidence of relevant experience designing at least 4 different traffic management plan types (all being approved by a client and successfully used in practice) including pedestrian and cyclist controls, lane closures and at least one of the following design types:
 - construction sites
 - public transport interfaces
 - using portable traffic control devices
 - roundabouts
 - high speed roads
 - Shoulder closures
 - motorways or freeways.

Course Outcome and Award

On successful completion of the assessment, Students will be issued with:

- Statement of Attainment issued by ATC
- TTM card issued by DIT (Department for Infrastructure and Transport)

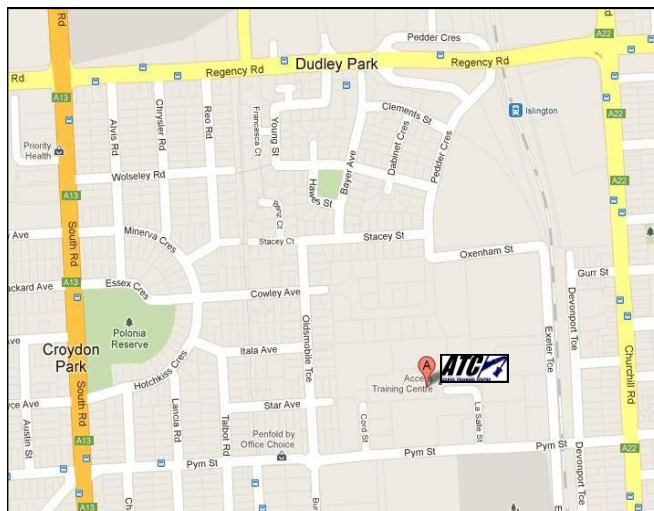

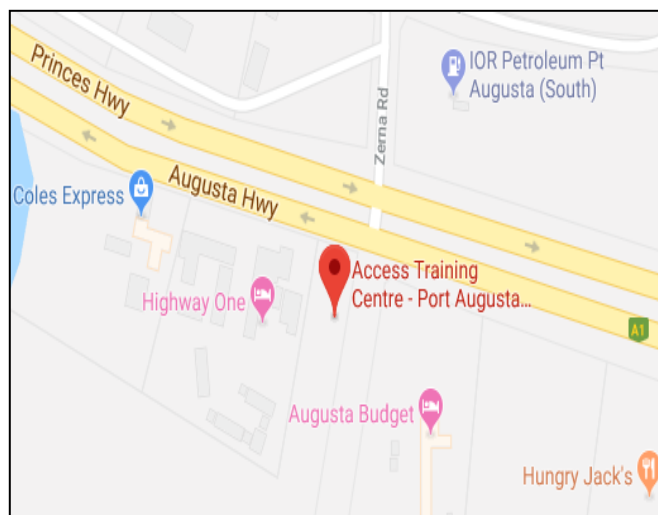
