The Utilities Temporary Traffic Management (TTM) Worker Accreditation course is designed for all workers employed directly or indirectly by a Utility organisation that provides basic public needs such as water, gas, electricity, communications.

Indirectly refers to companies who solely work to provide services to a provider of electricity, gas, water or communications.

Successful completion of this course provides the individual with the knowledge to perform duties as an infield Utilities worker which excludes the individual from performing the functions of a fully qualified Traffic Controller, Traffic Management Implementer or Traffic Management Designer.

Course Outcome and Award

On successful completion of the assessment, Students will be issued with:

- Certificate of Completion issued by ATC
- Utilities TTM card issued by DIT (Department for Infrastructure and Transport)

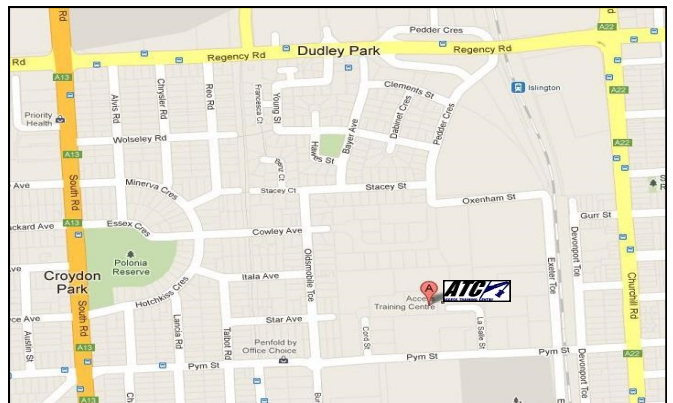
